2) Applicant Narrative

The CORPS Board of Directors requests that the scholarship applicant submit a maximum of a 250-word narrative that describes the applicant's goals for continued ballet training and how he plans to utilize the scholarship award. The narrative should be typed on a separate page and included in the application file.

3) Performance OR Rehearsal Sample

Include a web link (YouTube, Vimeo, etc. – along with any necessary password information) two electronically posted excerpts of performance *or* rehearsal classwork footage of a variation. Footage must contain a 1-2 minute classical or contemporary performance/variation.

Application Due Date: Monday, April 25, 2022 – 5:00 p.m., EDT. All materials must be received via email by this date and time. The awardee will be notified by Monday, May 9, 2022. The recipient will also receive a letter of congratulations and be announced at the CORPS de Ballet International Awards event the evening of Wednesday, June 22, 2022. (The recipient does not need to be present for the awards ceremony but may attend virtually, if able.)

2022 Check Sheet

1. Completed application with university dance program information and all up-to-date personal contact information.
2. A 250-word maximum narrative typed and submitted as a separate page and attached to the application, which includes what the scholarship will be used for – university tuition or summer study.
3. Classical or contemporary performance web link – 1-2 minutes in length. (Please be sure it works. If the committee cannot open the link then your application is considered incomplete and will not be considered.)

All applications must be complete and include each of the 3 points listed above as well as be submitted no later than April 25, 2022 – 5:00 p.m. EDT

Incomplete submissions will not be considered. Annual scholarship awards are determined by the CORPS de Ballet International Scholarship Committee.

You will receive a notice when all materials have been received and the submission is complete.
